Trilogy Education Fund

Thanks to the dedicated fundraising efforts of Trilogy Service Club at Monarch Dunes in Nipomo, South County Youth Coalition established an education and career readiness fund, which directed over \$14,000 to local students in 2022. A portion of the

fund supported 14 college-bound South County students identified with financial need. They were each awarded a \$500 grant used for computers, books, dorm supplies, luggage, travel costs, or other college-related expenses.



Parenting Classes

With the support of our partners at First 5, Parent Connection and Lucia Mar School District, SCYC offered over 100 parenting and parent-child participation classes in 2022. Targeting infants through teenagers, topics included nutrition, imaginative play, movement, healthy relationships, emotional safety, social media, bonding through art and resiliency. A selection of classes was offered in Spanish.





Womenade


